To All competitors

- 1) For safety reasons, the Stewards decided to complete the 2018 ELMS Sporting Regulations concerning the use of wheel guns during pit stops:

Art 10.8.3.2

For a wheel change, mechanics must:

- Bring a maximum of two pneumatic wheel guns into the working area;
- Without external assistance, take the new wheels, fit them on the car without laying them on the ground and put the replaced ones between the garage and the 2.5 m line or inside the garage;
- Carry at all times the detached wheels when they are outside the garage. However, in order to facilitate the wheel changes, it is possible to lay them flat on the ground near the car just during the change of the wheel concerned
- Not throw the wheels or drop them;
- Disconnect the air jacks and take the equipment back behind the 2.5 m line.
- Wheel change operations are allowed during refuelling operations.

- The wheel guns cannot be abandoned by the mechanics in the working area at any time.

- 2) The Stewards also clarify the functions of the mechanics wearing green armbands:

The mechanics with the green armbands can realise any intervention on the car, even inside the car (i.e the cockpit) and with tools if necessary.

The French interpretation of "on the car" must be understood on a global way and includes any part of the car.

The same mechanics with the green armbands can also remove the data USB stick for LMP3 cars.
