


THE LINE - SC RESTART LINE - RD SIGNALLING

ALL CARS TO SLOW DOWN TO 80km








INSIDE T1 / PIT EXIT ROAD





SAFETY CAR - RESTART Similar behavior concerning the relative position of the cars at the end of the FCY






YELLOW & DOUBLE YELLOW FLAG

- MARSHALS MAY BE EXPOSED

In VSC, SC, FCY and Red Flag procedures, any Marshal Post(s) that has any intervention in its sector will also signal with double waved yellow




