Fact: Allegedly Car 11 (driver Ian AGUILERA) caused a collision with car 60 (driver Alessio PICARIELLO) at

T5.

Offence: Alleged Breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2d of International Sporting Code

**Decision:** No further action.

**Reason:** The Stewards, summoned and heard from the Competitor and the driver concerned, and viewed

the circuit CCTV footage of the incident, car 11 presented a photo of the car which has no damage. The Stewards considered that there was no collision, but reminded the driver of the importance of overtaking cars of the slower category in a safe manner, as emphasised by the Race Director at the

Briefing.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code.
