The Stewards, having received a report from the ELMS Race Director, heard from the Team Representatives and the Drivers concerned, having examined video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

**N° / Driver:** 7 / Jens Reno MØLLER  
**Competitor:** VECTOR SPORT  
**Session:** Free Practice 1  
**Time (fact):** 12:27:32  
**Fact:** Alleged failure to follow the Race Director instructions at T2  
**Offence:** Alleged breach of Briefing Notes  
**Decision:** No further action.  
**Reason:** The Stewards, having summoned and heard from the Team Representatives and Drivers found that car 7 had just left the pits and was 80kph slower into turn 1 than car 77 immediately behind. The Stewards reminded both drivers about the proper procedure when leaving the pits and also when leaving and rejoining the track at turn 2. The Stewards determined that both drivers could have improved their actions in this situation, however there had been no breach of the regulations and therefore no action was necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
