The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter.

**N° / Driver:** 25 / Jake HUGHES  
**Competitor:** ALGARVE PRO RACING  
**Session:** Race  
**Time (fact):** 14:19:39  
**Fact:** Alleged causing a collision: car 25 and car 63 made contact at turn 13.  
**Offence:** Alleged breach of Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** No further action.

**Reason:** Car 25 was passing car 34 and 55 through turn 12 and approaching turn 13, sought to then pass car 63.  
Car 63 was already committed to the corner and car 25 as the faster car should have given room. The cars collided, car 63 continued whilst car 25 spun and continued.  
The Stewards determine that car 25 was predominantly responsible for the collision.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
