The Stewards, having received a report from the ELMS Race Director, summoned and heard from the Competitor's Representative and the Driver concerned, having checked the data evidence and having considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 51 / Charles-Henri SAMANI

Competitor: AF CORSE

Session: Bronze Driver Collective Test

Time (fact): 16:41:00

Fact: Allegation that Car 51 failed to significantly slow under yellow flags at T11- T12.

Offence: Alleged Breach of Appendix H, Article 2.5.5 b) of FIA ISC

Decision: No further action.

Reason: The Stewards summoned and heard from the Competitor's Representative and the Driver. All present reviewed the screenshot of the data provided by the Technical officials and the data provided by the Competitor. The driver stated that he had seen the incident and had sought to slow.

The Stewards determined that the data indicated that the driver had reduced the throttle and applied the brake sooner than in previous laps sufficient to reduce the overall speed. No further action was necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
